WTCC Core Leadership Team meeting

- ET proposes having an in-person Meetup after the pandemic ends, when we celebrate dropping the word “Coronavirus” to become simply “Wyoming Technology Coalition”
- ET’s plans for Thursday video: Past, present and future of WTCC
- Website has been updated in preparation for CNN documentary release
- Discussed whether/when to do a press release/news item re “Moonshot”
- Ryan Alford to prepare a weekly update/summary of what we’ve done past week for Governor to be sent every Sunday
- Ryan presented version 1 of contact tracing form he’s preparing
- Tyler Kerr said that he was approached by Wyoming Community Foundation offering a donation. Discussed what we might say about how such funds would be used.
- \$15K grant in process from Manufacturing Works and Wyoming Business Council to be used for supplies for sewing group and 3D printer filaments for smaller maker spaces statewide
- Discussed need for statewide “pony express” to deliver PPE from 3D printers to clinics/hospitals
- Lois Wingerson reported that Abbott a few hours previously announced release of COVID antibody test (which will allow knowledge of whether healthy people have been infected and are therefore immune and not potentially infectious)
- New volunteers attracted by ET video and CNN documentary to be directed to #volunteers channel/Britney Wallasch and urged to complete volunteer surveys and Slack profiles to help suggest how they can help
- Re “Moonshot” ET asked for a suggested deadline he can announce for the goal to have everyone in WY tested for COVID. Team asked to think about it for 24 hours. The final suggestion was to have the project plan complete within a month.
