WTCC Core Leadership Team meeting

- Microsoft \$10K check arrived today. No specifics requests for what it is to be used for.
- Discussed current status of WTCC as large group of volunteers under financial umbrella of Array Foundation, and whether and when it might become a more formalized, official organization.
- Discussed next news stories and press releases: Contact tracing, STEM project, and ShopWYO
- ET to talk with Melanie about immediate future of sewing project
- Question of need for redundancy of functions in case members get COVID
- Discussed need to have two people in conversations with government and other organizations
- Tyler Kerr reported on meetings with leadership in the 3D printing world around the state and coordination with Wyomakers in northeast of state which is working independently of WTCC.
- Also discussed creation of distribution network for PPE and perhaps testing.
- Ryan said that GIS team is talking about creating a WTCC resources map to coordinate supply locations in addition to usual COVID case information. This can be a demonstration to other agencies of its usefulness.
- Lois Wingerson presented new information about testing from conversations with Abbott and Darwin Biosciences. Also proposed creating a spreadsheet of other organizations in the state that are working on COVID relief.
- Each member asked to formulate questions the team should think about overnight.
