WTCC Core Leadership Team meeting

- ET gave another update on grants pending.
- Update on Slack. ET reported that we have been given another six months free service but must reduce apps we are using.
- Discussion of 3D printer priorities (see below). Effort is working at “over capacity.” Dental PPE has been given priority over request from Homeland Security. Is this correct?
- Update on WYSTEM online education project, begins next week. Discussion of whether social media should precede press release, and when press release should be sent.
- NCAR is reportedly joining the Folding project.
- Update on Moonshot project: Most of the research reports are in. Leadership team for project is beginning analysis; expect a full report within roughly a week. Nick urged to post the process and state of progress on the Community Channel.
- Nick G. and Ryan A. due to meet with Rene McKay of the Governor’s office at 11 AM Tuesday. Lengthy discussion of what they should say or ask. Decided that the focus of requests should be for names of contacts who are taking charge of state efforts in three areas: PPEs, contact tracing, and testing (e.g. who is in charge of assuring that Wyoming has adequate testing to reopen the economy)
- Brief discussion of “pony express” for PPE delivery, and of how to promote this to people currently making routine runs between relevant cities and to those currently out of work. Stress that travel costs would be reimbursed.
