WTCC Core Leadership Team meeting

- ET raised strategies for avoiding burnout and stress especially during family crises, and that it is OK to step back sometime and tune out. Asked members of the Executive Leadership Team individually to state how they are feeling about their commitments.
- Through Workforce Services, we will be able to hire between 2 and 15 temporary “helpers” for \$12 an hour if we need to. Discussed how such people might be deployed. Ideas: Community leader within WTCC, community representatives around the state, etc. Lars suggested phasing these assignments, starting with the community representatives. LW suggested hiring people for research. Discussed what job posting would look like. Decided to continue discussion on shared Google doc. Discussed whether to hire someone already in group or friends outside WTCC we can already recommend.
