WTCC Core Team meeting

- The meeting with Renny McKay was postponed until next Thursday, June 18th. This meeting will still focus on contract tracing.
- ET interviewed one candidate for our full-time positions sponsored by Wyoming Workforce Services. The remaining interviews will be scheduled during the rest of this week. The core team will review all interviews and decide on two candidates during next Monday night's meeting. Paperwork will be filled out on Tuesday with Workforce Services. The target start date for the two full-time positions will be Wednesday, June 17th.
- A reporter from Buffalo contacted ET about the Moonshot press release. The reporter was looking to see if anyone on the Moonshot project team was from Johnson County. No one from Johnson County was involved in the Moonshot project.
- No additional funding will be received from Wyoming Community Foundation (WYCF). A press release will be sent out this week about PPE production and funding.
- The core team had a discussion about burnout. The team is doing better at managing workloads. Many tasks will be offloaded to our full-time positions.
- Teal and Christine Porter were involved in a discussion with UW representatives. The WTCC was mentioned many times. There are a number of WTCC members who work for the UW system. Teal has offered our services for GIS.
- Nick had a discussion with the UW Economics Department. The Economics Department is interested in the behavioral economics around COVID-19 testing. There are plans to survey the state and identify places where people are more likely to take the COVID-19 test. It would be useful for the WTCC to be involved to help identify ideal locations for drive-through testing.
- ET recently had conversations with representatives and senators about technology. There is an opportunity for the WTCC to contribute towards the growth of technology in Wyoming. The WTCC will discuss the possibility of hosting a Tech Conference in 2020.
