

July 6, 2020

WTCC Core Team meeting

In attendance: ET, Jeremiah G., Nicholas G., Tyler K., Lars K., Jason M., Dawn S., Lois W., Teal W.

- Members of the team discussed who has been tested for COVID and whether others have had difficulty getting insurance to cover the cost. ET offered that WTCC could pay for tests for leadership team members for whom it is not covered, including antibody tests.
- Discussion about Thursday call with Renny. Teal offered to attend to give an update about the testing map. At Renny's request, Jason has emailed him a list of organizations that should be notified about the existence of the maps. Lois suggested informing Renny that we are creating a spreadsheet of all tests granted an EUA by the FDA, in consultation with Noah Hull of the DOH.
- Further conversation about what is our role for the future. ET asked what we could offer that isn't being offered elsewhere. Lois suggested creating an information resource for businesses about COVID information not currently provided by any other organization. Lars suggested surveying businesses about what they would like to know. ET suggested providing one-on-one consultations for businesses or schools that are looking for COVID-related information. He questioned whether we would be seen to have the credentials to offer definitive guidance. Nicholas raised the example of siliconslopes.com based in Utah, which is doing something similar. He suggested asking industry groups, rather than individual businesses, about their information needs and interests. Dawn suggested including a disclaimer that we are a volunteer group and that we are merely offering suggestions. Jason suggested that this information might be distributed via Chambers of Commerce. There was further discussion about possible legal risks of providing guidance and recommendations. Lars suggested we might become a resource for Wyoming-based news sources about COVID-related information.
